

## **VILLAGE MATTERS – JUNE 2007**

The GCA has recently been liaising with Yass Valley Council regarding the intended village entrance signs.

Council has indicated an intention to use the same format currently marking the entrances to Murrumbateman and other Yass Valley villages.

Neighbourhood noise in Gundaroo village, such as from machinery and dogs, has been raised as an issue within our community.
